Basket and Jewelry Making Classes







BASKET WEAVING

This class guides students through how to make a one-rod coiled basket with user-friendly raffia over a paper core. Examples of traditional California basket materials (willow, redbud, bracken fern root, sedge) and one- and three-rod coiled baskets will be on hand for examination and discussion, plus information about the baskets of the Miwuk, Pomo, and Paiute. Weavers will be able to take the materials home to finish their basket in their own time.
