


WRANGLER FOR A DAY

As the horses return from their adventure, you'll receive a hands-on lesson in post-ride care by assisting in getting them ready for their mid-day break. You'll be removing tack, grooming, checking for signs of soreness or fatigue, and so much more.

GROUP SIZE

1 participant per wrangler. Reservations recommended. Contact Guest Services for availability and pricing for additional participants.

PRICE

\$175 per person (age 10 and up). Includes one Horseback Riding Adventure and a lunch voucher for use in the Firefall Ranch General Store.

DIFFICULTY/AGE LIMIT

Participant should be comfortable around large animals. Suitable for individuals ages 10 and up (may require adult accompaniment).

MEETING PLACE

All trips meet at the Firefall Ranch reception desk 45 minutes before departure.

- At least 32 oz water and snacks
- Proper footwear—closed-toe shoes
- · Long pants recommended
- Bug repellant, sunscreen and sunglasses)
